John was the fireman on GG-1 #4876, leading train #173, THE FEDERAL, when it ran away and plowed into Washington Union Station on January 14, 1953. The train crashed through the station's wall, smashed through the stationmaster's office, which was just beyond the end of track 16, demolished the main news stand and was sliding across the concourse toward the waiting room when the floor gave way and the GG1 and two of the cars fell through the floor into the basement baggage room.

381 Wheatfield St., York, PA 17403

From Harrisburg:

- Interstate 83 South to Exit 19
- Head West on Market St./PA-462 towards the city of York
- At Harrison St. (where Market St. becomes one way the other way) turn left (South).
- Next traffic light is Princess St. make a right.
- Go to 940 E. Princess St., which is where Wheatfield St. is.
- Turn left (South) to 381 Wheatfield St. on the East side of the street.

From Lancaster:

- Take Route 30 West towards York
- Make a left on the Sherman St. exit, which is East of the Harley Davidson Motorcycle plant.
- Cross Market St and turn left at E. Princess St.
- Go to 940 E. Princess and follow Wheatfield to the club.
